Advisory votes have been added by initiatives to the ballot three times in the last fifteen years, each time by over a 70%+ margin of Washington State voters. Only to have them removed from the ballot by Democrat Legislators and Auditors, as they did so again in 2023.

We believe;

- 1. Advisory vote notices on taxes and expenditures on the ballot are the most cost-effective way to remind and educate the voters about what was done to them in the previous year.
- 2. Advisory vote notices hold our public officials accountable before they are elected to tax and spend even more money in the next election cycle.
